As you all know, our Board has been working hard on our financial situation. Kathy Littlefield has been working very hard to reconcile our checking account and make sure that by the District meeting, all our finances are as accurate as possible. All of her findings have been turned over to the Scottsdale Police. Their investigation continues. At the time of this newsletter, there are several thousand dollars that are unaccounted. The most frustrating thing about this for me is that it creates such a distraction during such an important time. While we have taken steps to make sure that all District activities continue, it seems like the energy put into resolving this issue could be better spent getting our candidates elected. Fortunately, the State Party decided to rent space in the middle of our District which meant that we did not need this expenditure.

Finally, please consider running for office. The Board has extended the deadline for submission of names to the date of the next meeting. While names can be submitted from the floor at the November meeting, it is valuable for all of us to get to know the candidates ahead of time and not have to make a decision based on a brief speech at the Organization Meeting.

FIRST VICE CHAIRMAN – TRACY MUNSIL

Our district total is 299 elected PCs, which gives us 100 state committeemen, who will be elected at our district organizational meeting in November and will serve for the next two years. PC training handbooks will be available at the October meeting. Thanks for your willingness to be part of the grassroots efforts of the Republican Party and to serve in the capacity of PC for 2011-2012.

Now that we have the official list of PCs, we are currently electing precinct captains for the precincts. The captains pass on information to the precinct committeemen. The captain election form is available on district's website. PCs from each precinct are required to sign the form to confirm that they have elected their captain. This has to be done every two years when we elect our new precinct committeemen. SECOND VICE CHAIRMAN – CHAD WILLEMS

Our guest speaker for October will be Doug Hebert, who will be discussing Proposition 203 "The Medical Marijuana Act." Mr. Hebert is a Board Member of the Partnership for Drug Free America / Arizona Affiliate, after retiring in November 2009 from the United States Department of Justice Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA), where he served for 26 years.

In his latest position as DEA's Assistant Special Agent in Charge of the Phoenix Field Division, Mr. Hebert, supervised enforcement groups, state and local task forces, money laundering operations, training and diversion. In 2009, as part of a DEA Nationwide initiative, Mr. Hebert established two Tactical Diversion Task Forces in Arizona to address the diversion of pharmaceutical controlled substances throughout the State of Arizona. Currently, Mr. Hebert is on the steering committee for Keep Arizona Drug Free (keepazdrugfree.com) which opposes Proposition 203 "The Medical Marijuana Act."

DISTRICT 8 MINUTES – BARBARA MCMULLEN, INTERIM SECRETARY

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM by Chairman Dr. James Burke. Officers in attendance were Tracy Munsil, and Chad Willems. Tracy Munsil opened with the invocation and Pledge of Allegiance in Rev. C. T. Wright's absence. There were 75 Precinct Committeemen present and 9 guests.

First item on the agenda was the Nominating Committee. In the absence of the chairman, Barbara McMullen, committee member Rob Perelka read the instructions for having your name placed on the ballot for election on Nov. 20. Those instructions are listed below.

The Chairman also announced that the Arizona State Party has opened a headquarters in the same building as the Schweikert campaign, which is located, on the corner of Goldwater Boulevard and Indian School Road in Scottsdale. At those headquarters volunteers will be making phone calls, etc., and Paula Linker is heading up that project, so please contact her, pb415linker@cox.net. You have received e-mails from Paula, so please contact her and volunteer. Monday night is the first night.

Chairman Burke introduced Scottsdale City Councilman Ron McCullagh. The program consisted of Tim Bray, candidate for re-election to the Central Arizona Water Conservation District, Representative Michele Reagan, candidate for State Senate, District 8, Representative John Kavanagh, candidate for re-election to the Arizona House of Representatives, District 8 and Michelle Ugenti, candidate for the Arizona House of Representatives, District 8.

Tim Bray gave a brief synopsis of what the CAWCD did and answered a question relative to EPA's statement that it will shut down the Navajo Generating Plant if the State did not spend close to a billion dollars to curb the emissions supposedly going to the Grand Canyon. The CAWCD is the largest user of this energy and if it is closed they will have to purchase energy elsewhere and your bill will show a 300% increase. There are emission scrubbers on the plant now but the EPA wants more.

Rep. Michele Reagan thanked the District 8 precinct committeemen and women for their continued help to her in her campaign and how proud she is of all of the candidates who ran for the vacant House seat and how they campaigned with class and showed no animosity toward one another.

Michelle Ugenti also thanked the precinct committeemen and women for their help in her campaign. She said she would work hard for the people of District 8 and was looking forward to being a legislator.

Rep. Kavanagh was running between two meetings and brought yard signs for people to take. He said his main concern is balancing the budget and as Chairman of the House Appropriations Committee that was his first priority.

Chairman Burke spoke to those in attendance concerning a problem the district has had in filing its financial reports. It seems names were not removed from the rolls from the prior administration and that caused the problem. However, he assured everyone in attendance that the issue had been resolved and that payment of the fine would not be placed on the District. The Chairman himself has paid the fine himself out of campaign funds he had in a campaign account. Everyone applauded the Chairman.

Chairman Burke gave future events for the District. December the 9th is the annual Holiday Party. He also has invited the District to his home for an open house to thank Senator Carolyn Allen for her 16 years of service to District 8. The date is Nov. 11. As the date approaches you will receive further notice.

Boe James, Chairman of the Fountain Hills Republican Club gave the agenda for upcoming events in Fountain Hills.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:55 PM. Next meeting is Oct. 14.

Rules For Getting On The Ballot For Office And State Committeeman For District 8 Republican Committee

The Nominating Committee is seeking candidates to serve as officers for Legislative District 8 Republican Committee and for State Committeemen. These positions will be voted on at our organizational meeting Nov. 20, 2010. In order to qualify you must be an elected precinct committeeman who was on the ballot and elected at the Aug. 24, 2010 primary election. The slate of officers will be presented at the Oct. 14 meeting of the District.

Candidates for office are asked to submit a brief resume which tells about their political experience. Example being a precinct committeeman, running as a candidate for political office, being a member or committee member of a political group such as the Arizona Federation of Republican Women, Scottsdale Republican Forum, Fountain Hills Republican Club etc. Responsibilities of the officers can be found in the District Bylaws which are on our website.

The Officers are: Chairman; First Vice- Chairman/Membership; Second Vice-Chairman/Programs; Secretary and Treasurer. **Deadline to submit application to the Nominating Committee is Oct. 30, 2010.**

State Committeemen:

State Committeemen represent Legislative District 8 at the State Mandatory Meeting and the County Mandatory Meeting which are held in January of each year. They are responsible for electing the officers of the State Party and may run for office as an AZGOP officer or member of the State Executive Committee.
